and separation distance of the bollards;
  - (b) The specific locations of the proposed works clearly defined  
on a large scale site layout;
  - (c) Additional protective inbuilt landscaping for the purpose  
of ensuring that mopad and cycle movements through the  
separation gaps between the bollards can be prevented.
