In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ A/2729/79 dated 23rd November, 1979, decide to refuse:

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development, <sup>which</sup> envisages the obstruction of previously approved local distributor road serving both Wellington Estate and the adjoining area would contravene materially a condition attached to an existing permission for the development i.e. condition No. 1 of Order P/811/77 dated 11.3.77 (K.1913).
2. The proposed development, which envisages the obstruction of a previously approved local distributor road, would inhibit the completion of necessary road construction works required to be carried out by the estate developers and forming an integral part of the road network for the area, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

With reference to your planning application received here on 13th July, 1979, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Further information is required which should provide for the following:
  - (a) Specific details of the proposed works, i.e., type, dimensions and separation distance of the bollards;
  - (b) The specific location of the proposed works clearly defined on a large scale site layout;
  - (c) Additional protective inbuilt landscaping for the purpose of ensuring that moped and cycle movements through the separation gaps between the bollards can be prevented.

**NOTE:** The applicants must consult with the County Council before submitting any further information.
