CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. External finishes of proposed new classrooms, to harmonise with those of existing building.
7. Proposed new wall to be suitably capped and finished.
8. Off-street carparking in accordance with the requirements of the Development Plan to be provided.
9. Locations of boundary walls and gates on Newlands Ave. to be the subject of agreement with Roads Engineer. A footpath to be provided on the north side of Newlands Ave.

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
3. In the interests of public health.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
