That the applicant make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.</p> <p>4. That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense if such is necessary, for the purposes of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.</p> <p>5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.</p> <p>6. That the exact location of the shelter be checked on site by the area engineer and agreed in writing before development commences.</p>	<p>1.
