AN BORD PLEANALA

APPEAL by Maiden Poster Sites of 25 Upper Mount Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 21st day of February, 1984, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of two advertising structures on a temporary basis at Ballymount Road, Walkinstown, Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said two advertising structures for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The site is located in an area zoned to provide for industrial and related uses. The retention of these large obtrusive signs, unacceptably located in close proximity to the public road boundary would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the visual amenities of the area.
