Dear Sirs,

With reference to your planning application received here on 22nd December, 1983, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963-1983, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The site of the proposed development is located in an area zoned "to protect and provide for the further development of agriculture". The applicant is requested to indicate how the development might be considered compatible with this use zoning.
2. There is no spare capacity in the Newcastle Foul sewerage system due to lack of dilutions in Griffeen. The applicant is requested to indicate if he is in a position to provide for an alternative means of drainage. If a septic tank system is proposed it must be in accordance with the requirements of the Supervising health Inspector, Dublin County Council and the applicant should consult with the Supervising Health Inspector prior to submission of additional information.
3. An Riann Cosanta are of the opinion that the proposed development is sited in sub-area 'A' of the Department of Defence "protected area", and would therefore interfere with the operation and development of air traffic at Casement Aerodrome. The applicant is asked to clarify if he can overcome the objection of AN Riann Cosanta.
