That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required. 2. That a financial contribution in the sum of £320. be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid immediately on receipt of the grant of permission. 3. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer be adhered to in the development. 4. That the proposed structure shall be used only for the purposes set out in the letter of application dated 5th June, 1979. 5. That the drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. 6. That the proposed structure be located not less than thirty feet from the highway boundary. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained. 2. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services. 3. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard. 4. To prevent unauthorised development. 5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964. 6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
