APPEAL by John Hynes, of Aqua House, Moneenalion Commons Lower, Kingswood County Dublin, against the decision made on the 28th day of June, 1979 by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse permission for the retention of a television aerial at Moneenalion Commons Lower, Kingswood:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said television aerial for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The retention of the television aerial would endanger public safety because it would constitute an obstruction to air traffic due to its height and location in relation to Casement aerodrome.
