In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ **P/2520/79** dated **27th June 1979** decide to refuse:

For **Proposed depot for waste removal lorries, mechanical plant and motor vehicles:**

at Kilnamangh House, Greenhills Road.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the unacceptable heavy vehicular turning movements generated by this development, located at a point where vision splays are limited on the heavily trafficked Greenhills Road,
2. The site is seriously affected by the Council's major road Improvement Schemes for this area and if scheduled for acquisition by the Council as envisaged in Dublin County Council's Compulsory Purchase (Tymon North, Kilmanagh/Tallaght, Templeogue/Greenhills) Order, 1973 for the purpose of carrying out these major Road Improvement Schemes.
