4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. Any necessary water storage for fire provision purposes is to be provided.
5. That any necessary requirements of the Council's Building Control Department be complied with in the development.

2. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
