With reference to your planning application received here on 30th January, 1979, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Applicant to indicate on a map the total curtilage and acreage of the farm owned by his father in the area.
2. Applicant to submit evidence of his need to live on his father's farm.
3. Adequate and satisfactory evidence that the site proposed is suitable for septic tank drainage, including soil suitability and adequate percolation areas. Satisfactory evidence is also required that an adequate and potable water supply can be provided.

Note: The applicant should consult with the Health Inspectors Department, 33, Rutland Place, before submitting information requested in 3 above.

The applicant should mark his reply 'Additional Information' and quote the Register Reference Number given above.
