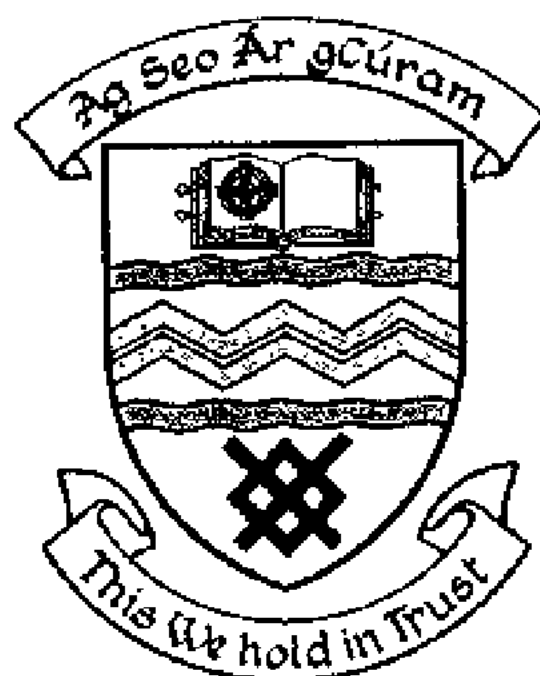

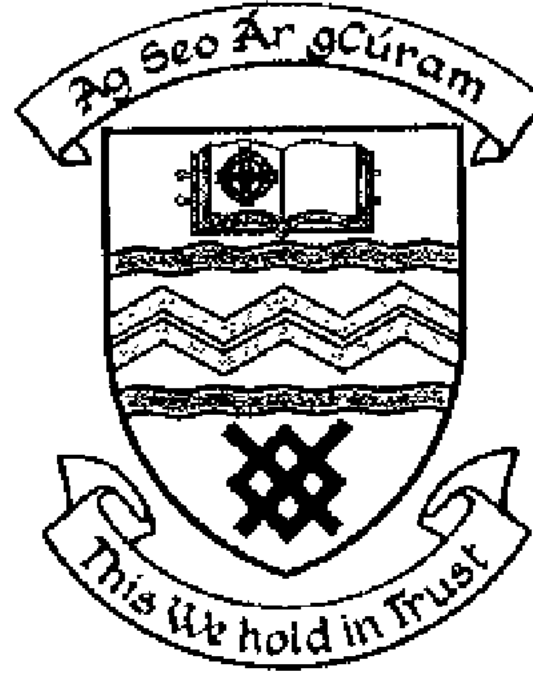

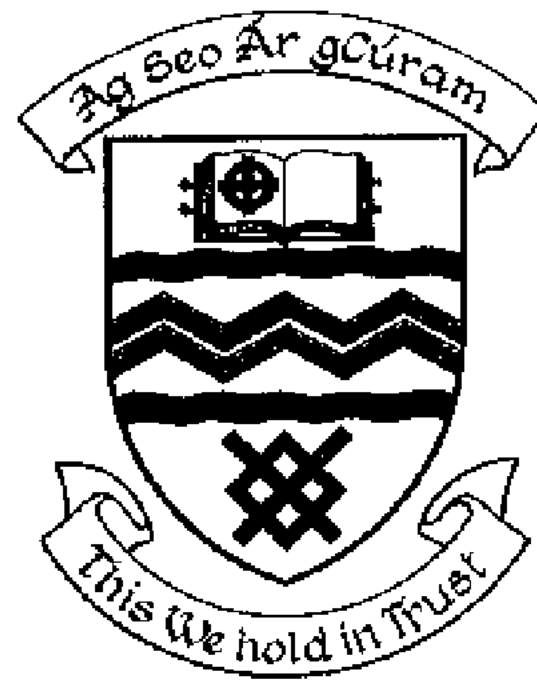

 REASON:

 REASON:

 - 4 The foundations of the proposed extension shall be laid down below the invert level of the existing drainage pipelines located in the adjoining footpath.

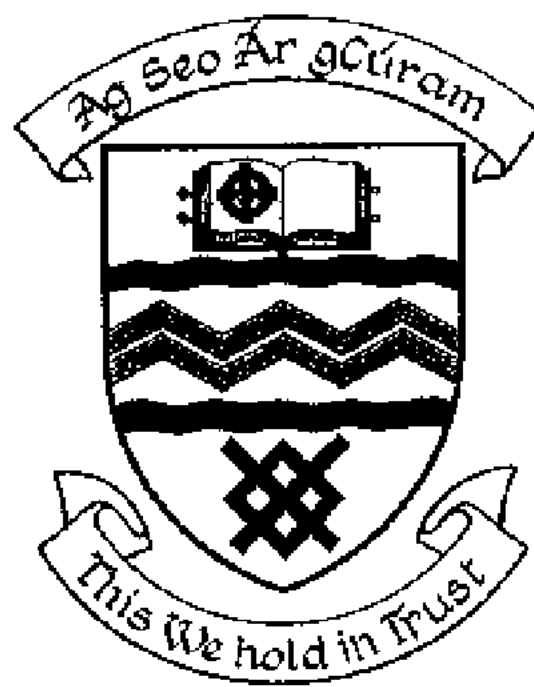
