

The development to be carried out in its entirety in 1 accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

REASON:

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

Full details of the proposed shopfront signage shall be submitted for the written agreement of the Planning Authority prior to the commencement of development. proposed fascia signage shall comprise only of either individual solid letters which shall be mounted directly onto the fascia or shall be painted directly onto the fascia. If it is proposed to install fascia signage comprising of individual solid letters onto the fascia, the signage shall not be internally illuminated or lit by means of external light fittings.

REASON:

In the interests of visual amenity and in order to protect the integrity of Lucan Village, a designated Conservation Area.

- The following shall apply to the permitted shopfront:-3
 - The glazing of the shop shall be kept free of all **a**) stickers, posters and other such material.
 - No goods, sandwich boards or similar structures b) shall be displayed on the public footpath or outside the premises.
 - The sound level of any loud speaker announcement, C) music or other material projected in or from the premises shall be controlled so as to ensure the sound is not audible in adjoining premises or the overhead apartments or at two metres from the frontage.
