

APPEAL by More O'Ferrall of Beech House, Beech Hill Road, Dublin against the decision made on the 1st day of June, 2000 by the Council of the County of South Dublin to refuse permission for development comprising the retention of four advertising signs at Nangor Road, beside Courts Furnishings at the junction with Killeen Road, Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1999, permission is hereby refused for the said development for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- It is considered that the advertising signs proposed to be retained, by reason of their height, size and location, would conflict with and be contrary to the objectives for advertisements as set out in the current Development Plan for the area. The proposed retention of the signs would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- It is considered that the advertising signs proposed to be retained, by reason of 2. their size and location on a district distributor road, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard. The proposed retention of the signs would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

Reasons

- The signs by reason of their size, location and design will attract the attention of road users thereby causing a distraction to road users and endangering public safety by reason of a traffic hazard. This would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The signs would set a precedent for the erection of further signs along this class of road (district distributor) and would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area. The signs would also be contrary to the provision in the South Dublin County Council Development Plan, 1998, paragraph 3.6.1.i.
