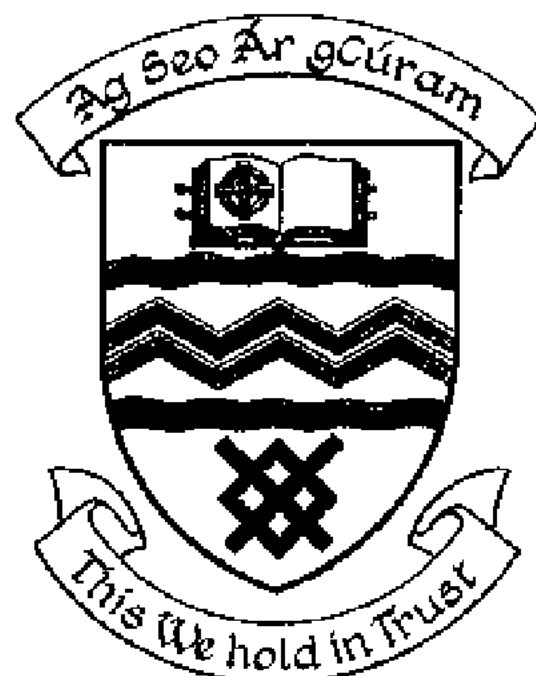

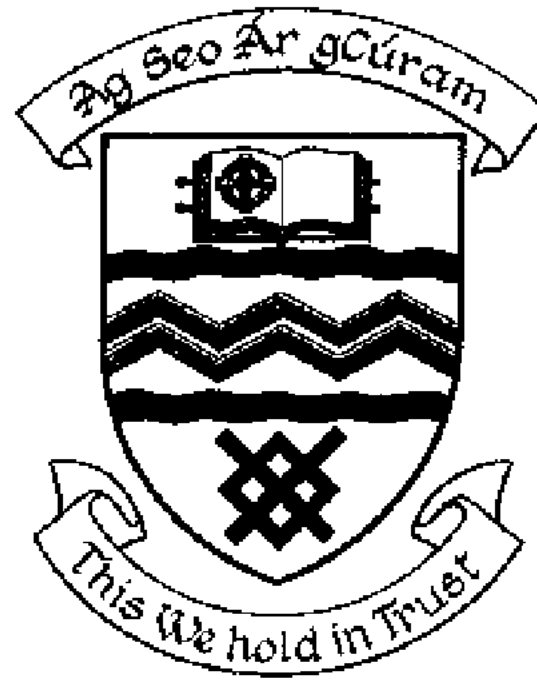

Reasons

- 1 The normal Roads Department minimum 'setback' of 2 metres between the side wall of a house and the back edge of the public pathway is not provided for. As such the proposal would constitute sub-standard, disorderly development contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- 2 There would be less than 2.3 metres minimum gap between the nearest side walls of the existing and proposed houses as required by Section 3.4.19 of the South Dublin County Development Plan, 1998.
- 3 The proposed development on a restricted corner site would produce a cramped appearance and be unduly visually prominent in the street scene. As such the proposed development would seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity.
- 4 The submitted plans do not indicate whether the necessary distances will be available between the proposed building and any existing sewers and watermains in the adjacent public pathway/verge/road. As such the proposed development must be considered prejudicial to public health.
- 5 The proposed development would result in the foul drainage and surface water being connected to a drain. The proposal would therefore be prejudicial to public health and contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
