

#### Reasons

- The proposed development by reason of its location, would interfere to an unacceptable degree with the established building line on St. Malachy's Drive, and as such, would contravene materially a development objective of the South Dublin County Development Plan 1998 (para 3.4.13.i) with regard to the maintenance of existing building lines. The proposed development would therefore seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity, and would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would be prejudicial to public health due to its location in proximity to existing public services (a 225mm diameter surface water sewer and 100mm diameter watermain) located adjacent to the site.
