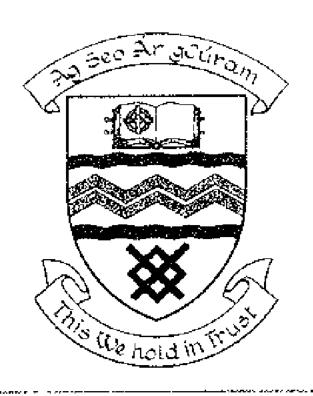

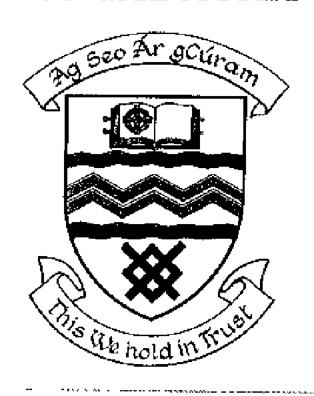

- With regard to the cottage at Chainage 500 on Drg. R1 Rev A the proposal in its current form is not considered acceptable. The applicants are requested to clarify how it is intended to revise the current scheme to a more acceptable proposal. In this regard, the applicants shall consider the recommendations of the Roads Department with respect to acquiring land from the cottage owner or relocating the road away from the cottage, thereby requiring additional land on northern side of road.
- The applicants are requested to clarify whether the proposed culvert could be constructed without encroaching onto land in private ownership.
- With regard to the stream which is shown culverted in a 1050mm diameter pipe, the applicants are requested to clarify whether a structural culvert would be required due to the position of the road and the lack of cover.
- 5 The applicants are requested to clarify the discrepancy between the position of the retention pond, granted planning permission under S99A/0339, and the road widening proposed under the current application.
