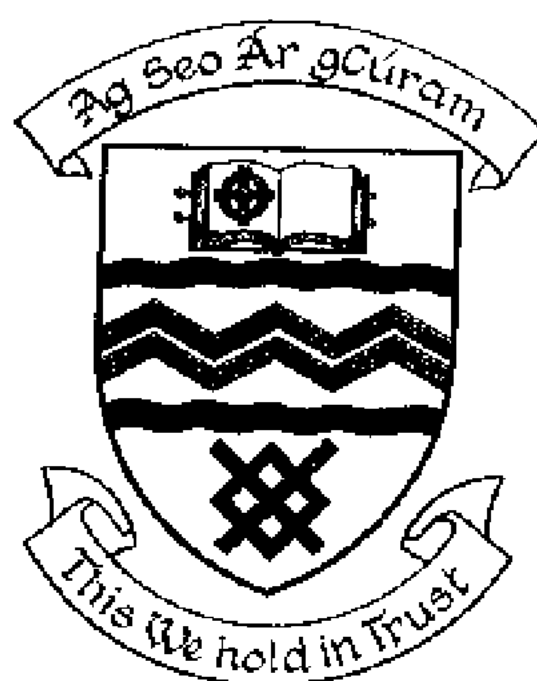

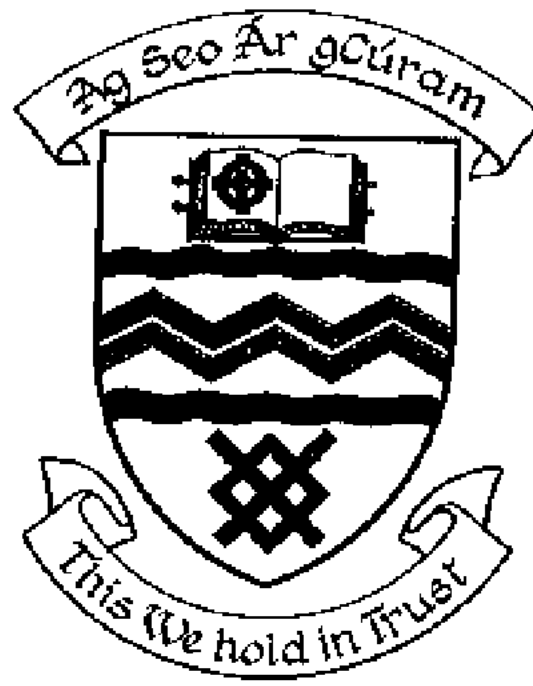

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A decision to **Refuse Permission** for erection of new polyclad tunnels and revised entrance to site subject to (2) reasons specified in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1

Conditions and Reasons

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the generation of traffic turning movements at a location where vision is deficient as a result of substandard vision splays at the junction of Old Court Lane and Old Court Road.
2. The proposed development constitutes undesirable ribbon development on a substandard rural road network, which will lead to a demand for the uneconomic provision of services and would set an undesirable precedent for similar developments in the area.

A decision to **Refuse Outline Permission** for a bungalow for the (3) reasons specified in Schedule 2.

Schedule 2

Reasons

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the generation of traffic turning movements at a location where vision is deficient as a result of substandard vision splays at the junction of Old Court Lane and Old Court Road.
2. The proposed development constitutes undesirable ribbon development on a substandard rural road network, which will lead to a demand for the uneconomic provision of services and would set an undesirable precedent for similar developments in the area.
3. The applicant has not demonstrated that the site is suitable for the treatment of the domestic effluent and has provided insufficient details of proposed water supply. The grant of outline permission for a bungalow would therefore be prejudicial to public health.
