#### Reasons

- Having regard to the loss of the existing screening vegetation along the site boundaries and to the elevated position of the proposed house and balcony in relation to adjacent property, it is considered that the proposed development would seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity by reason by reason of undue overlooking and visual obtrusion.
