

APPEAL by Joseph Hickey of 32, Rathe Lawns, Rathcoole, County Dublin against the decision made on the 4th day of October, 1983, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the erection of an extension, to be used as a grocery shop, at the side of 32 Rathe Lawns, Rathcoole, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983 permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said extension for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

### SCHEDULE

The site of the proposed development is located in a residential estate at the end of a cul-de-sac road which fronts on to a public open space area for the estate. The proposed development by virtue of its character and the anticipated scale of activity likely to be generated by it would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the estate in general and in particular to the properties in the immediate vicinity of the site.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An Appeal lodged by an applicant or gent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (2) A party to an appeal nusting a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral Hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten Pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
