REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. That the development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
2. That the applicant indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.
3. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure,
4. That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.
5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.
6. That the shelter be placed at the back of the footpath and the side panels be eliminated. The precise location of the shelter to be agreed with the Area Engineer, Roads Department.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. In the interest of amenity and public safety.
4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
