Reasons

- Having regard to the proposed installation for mobile antennae which would project 2.6 metres over the height of the building which is listed for protection in the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan, in addition to the proposed two dish antennas which will be one metre over the height of the building, which, in the opinion of the Planning Authority accentuates the visual impact of the proposal, it is considered that the proposal would be contrary to the policy of the Council in relation to the preservation of buildings, structures and sites as set out in paragraph 2.7.3 of the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan, and would be seriously injurious to both the amenities of the building and property in the vicinity.
- That the proposed installation for mobile antennae on a building which is listed for protection in the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan is contrary to the policy of the Council in relation to accepting, as a minimum standard, the document "Telecommunications Antennae and Support Structures Guidelines for Planning Authorities" by the Department of the Environment which states in paragraph 4.3 that the erection of installations in proximity to listed buildings should be avoided. The proposal would set an undesirable precedent for other similar developments on the building in question and on other listed buildings throughout the County and is therefore contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
