APPEAL by David Allen Poster Contractors of 61, Nore Road, Dublin Industrial Estate, Glasnevin, Dublin against the decision made on the 23rd day of September, 1983, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of an advertising sign on a site at Keatings Park, Naas Road, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said advertising sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The retention of the sign, by reason of its excessive size, prominence and location adjacent to the national primary route, would cause an unacceptable distraction to traffic thereby endangering public safety by reason of a traffic hazard. In addition, the retention of the sign would be seriously injurious to the visual amenities of this rural area.

In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Acts, the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ A/2141/83 dated 23rd September, 1983, decided to refuse:

For retention of sign at Keatings Park, Co. Dublin.

for the following reasons:

1. The retention of this obtrusive and large sign, immediately adjoining the Naas Road Dual Carriageway National Primary Route N7 would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because signs of this magnitude dwarf statutory road signs and compete for the attention of motorists with consequent distraction on this heavily trafficked fast National Primary Route and would result in a serious traffic hazard.
2. The site is located in an area zoned to protect and provide for the development of agriculture. The retention of this large obtrusive sign in a rural area would contravene materially the above objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An Appeal lodged by an applicant or agent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral Hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten Pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
