CONDITIONS

1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That a financial contribution in the sum of £3,257. be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which will facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts 1878-1964.
3. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
4. In the interest of health.
5. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
