Reasons

- The site of the proposed development is located in an area which is subject to the zoning objective "to protect and enhance the outstanding natural character of the Dublin Mountain Area". It is Council policy that dwellings will only be permitted in such areas where the applicant is a native of the area; can demonstrate a genuine need for housing in that particular area and where the development is directly related to the area's amenity potential or to its use for mountain or hill farming. The applicant has not established a sufficient case in this regard. The proposed development would therefore materially contravene the zoning objective for the area and, as such, would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would interfere with a view of special amenity which it is an objective of the current Development Plan to preserve and would be detrimental to the visual amenities of the area. The proposed development would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development constitutes undesirable ribbon development on a substandard rural road network, which would lead to a demand for the uneconomic provision of services and would set an undesirable precedent for further similar developments in the area.
- There is insufficient information in the application documentation to determine the suitability of the site for the disposal of foul effluent as proposed.


