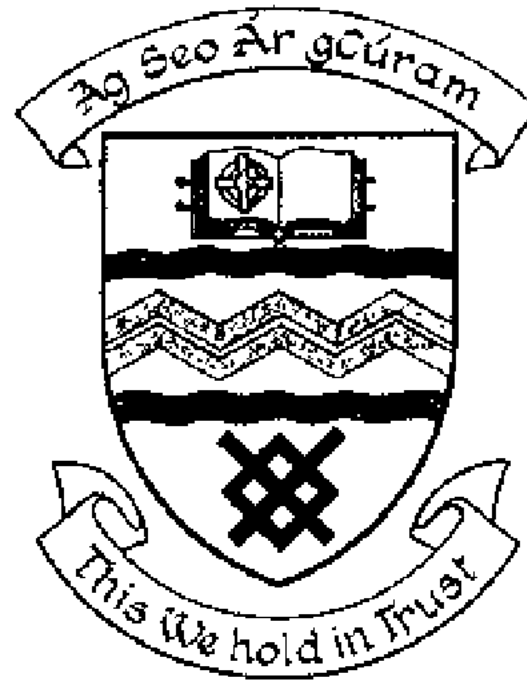
- 1 The subject site incorporates an area to the front of the existing garage and to the side of the existing dwelling which appears to be in communal use and thus outside the applicant's ownership. The applicant is requested to submit a land registry map and folio which clearly indicates the extent of the lands in the applicant's ownership.
- 2 The proposed extension to the rear of the dwelling would appear to constitute a granny flat as the proposed accommodation comprises a bedroom, bathroom and kitchen. The applicant is requested to clarify whether or not it is proposed to provide a granny flat to the rear of the dwelling. In the event of such, the applicant is requested to re-advertise the proposed development and to submit revised site and newspaper notices indicating same. Details of the circumstances under which a granny flat is required to be provided should also be submitted.

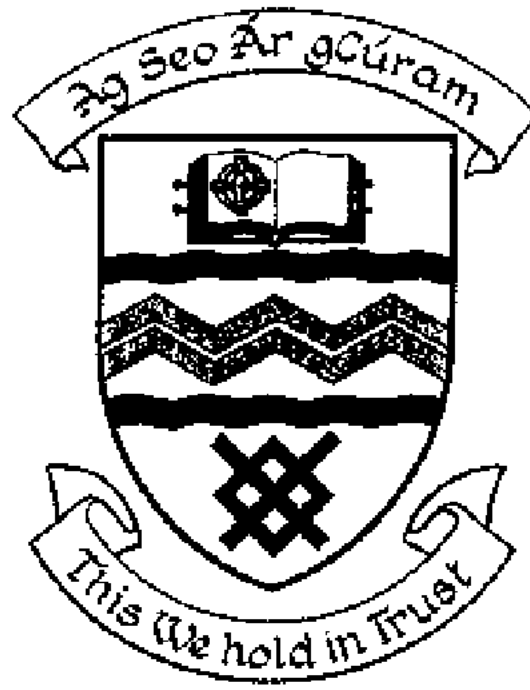
