NOTE : The applicant is advised to consult with the Environmental Services Engineer prior to submission of Additional Information.

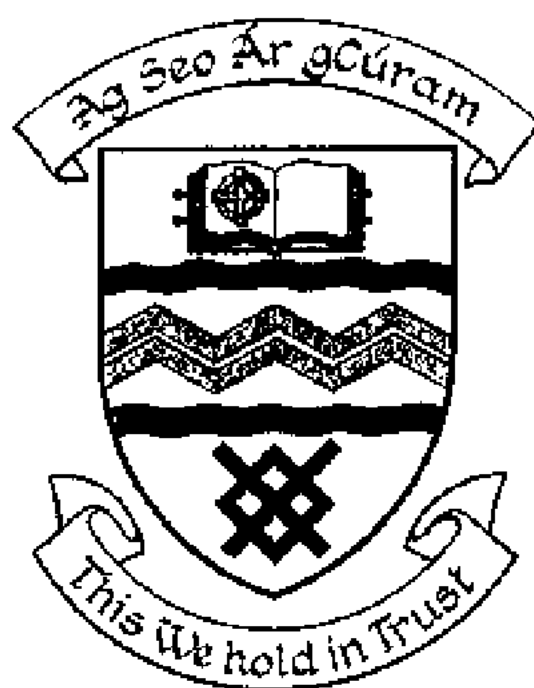

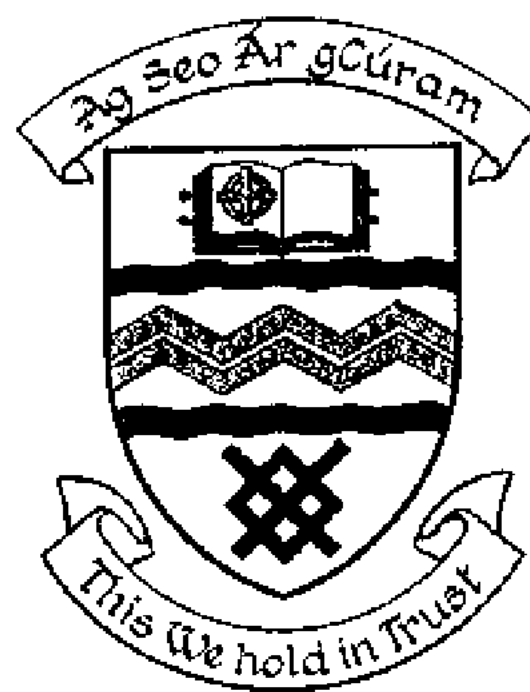
- (a) two copies of the text of the notice
