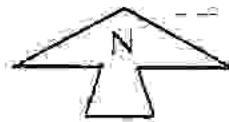

5. That the proposed double telephone kiosk be relocated to the south-east at least 2.5 metres from the pedestrian entrance to the Cappaghmore Estate and within 1.5 metres of the existing boundary wall to the south-west to avoid obstruction of pedestrians at this location.

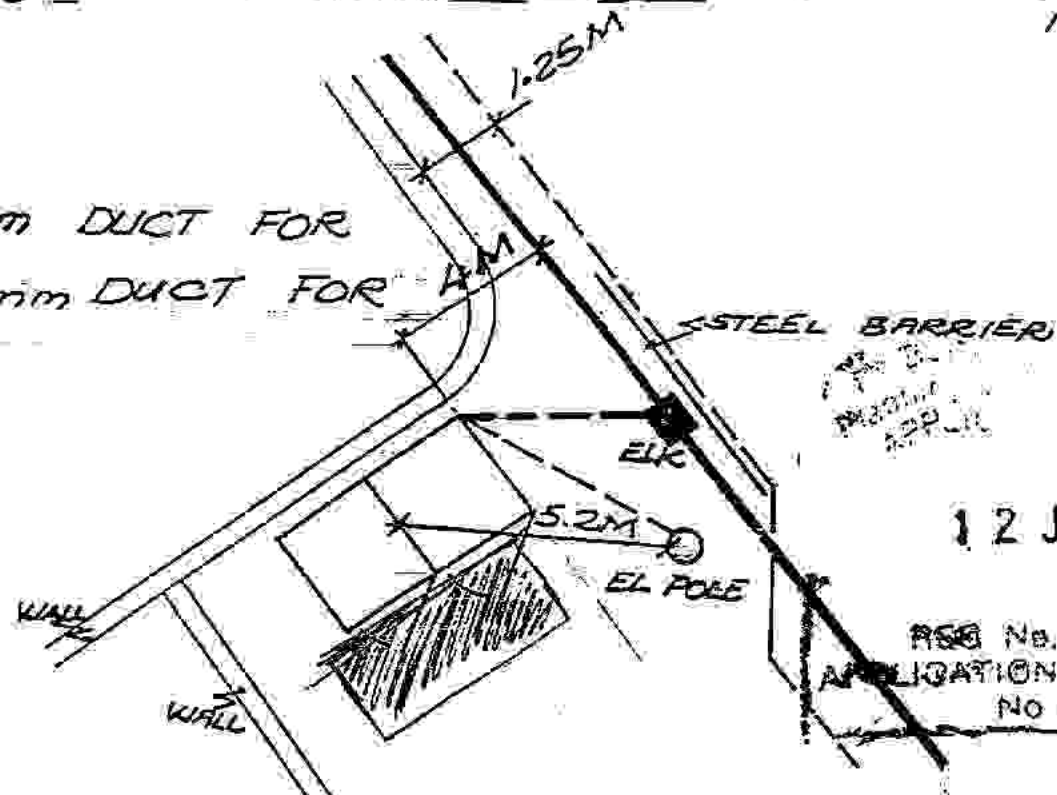

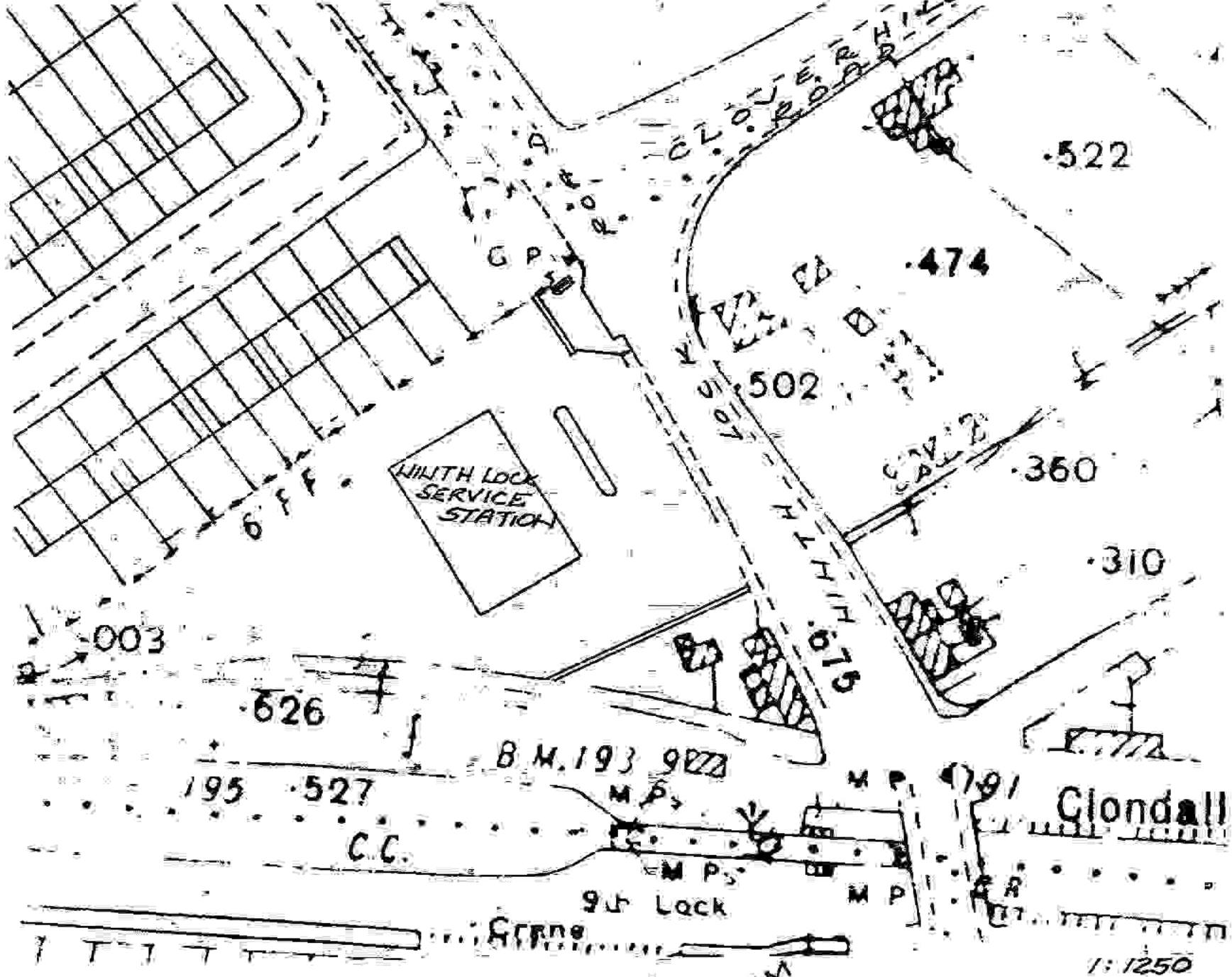

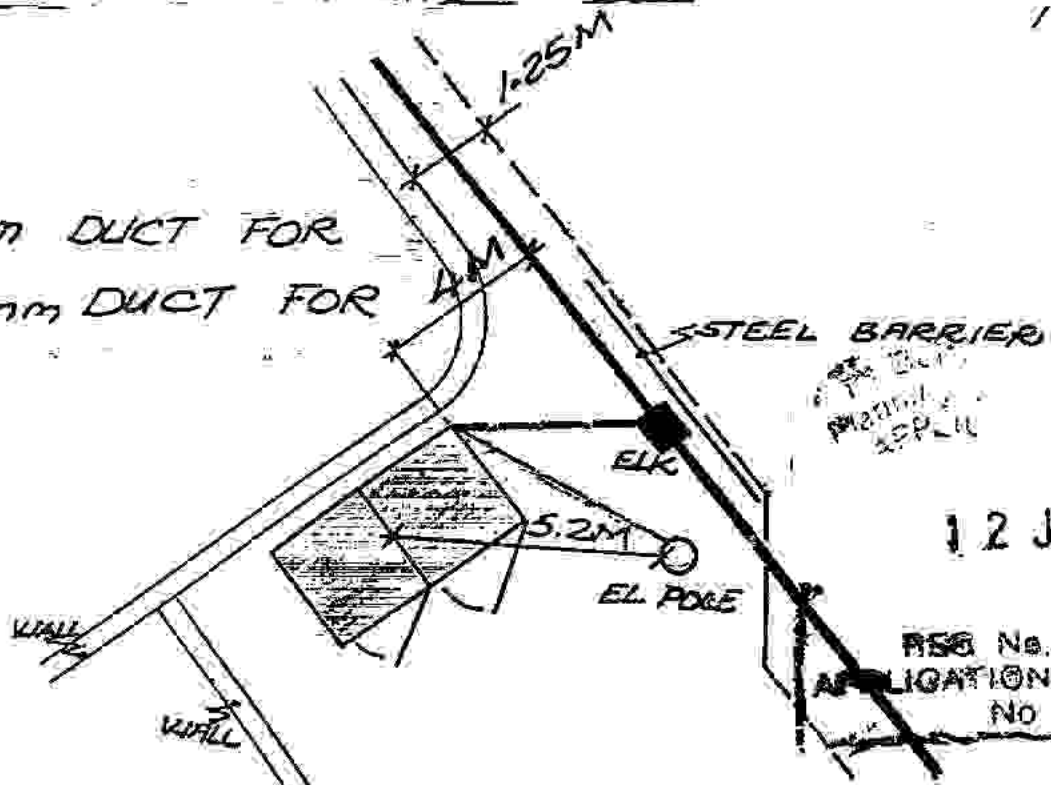
