I refer to your submission of 9th October, 1991, being a claim for exemption under Class 25B(c) of the Local Government (Planning and Development) (Postal and Telecommunications) (Exempted Development) Regulations, 1983.

Class 25B(c) states that telephone kiosks in a public place are exempted development provided that no such kiosk is situated within 10 metres of the curtilage of any dwelling house.

As the proposed kiosk would appear to be located within 10 metres of the curtilage of a dwelling house to the east of the site, planning permission would be required in this instance.
