This is an application for PERMISSION for construction of indoor riding arena at Badgerhill, Kill, Co. Kildare for Oldmill Riding Centre.

The site forms part of a 30 acre area of farming land of which some is used as a riding school. Decision Order PA/3836/79, Reg. Ref. SA 1745, a bungalow was permission at Badgerhill to the same applicant. The farm holding is divided by the county road. The proposed indoor riding arena is located to the west of the county road. The permitted bungalow and other farm yard is located to the east of the county There are a number of large barns in the vicinity of the application and the proposed riding arena would not be of a greater elevational height than these farm buildings. 




