NOVAK Djokovic will need to spend

some time on the sidelines recovering from a muscle tear that hindered him in the later rounds of the Australian Open, the Serbian said as he celebrated his ninth Melbourne Park title. The 33-year-old extended his own record with an emphatic 7-5 6-2 6-2 victory over Daniil Medvedev at the Rod Laver Arena on Sunday, despite carrying the injury suffered in the third round. Djokovic said a second scan of his abdomen had revealed he had made the injury worse by playing on. He said: 'The damage is bigger than what it was when it happened, when I did the first MRI after the third round.'
