The Church of the Holy Spirit, Ballyroan is a 'Protected Structure' and the proposed mast site is within the curtilage of this protected structure. This application should not be allowed to proceed as it would undermine the integrity of the protected structure.

Furthermore the height of the mast at 20meters would be visually and physically detrimental to the aesthetics of the church, the plaza and the surrounding area. It also reduces significantly the space available to the church congregation and

local residents for fetes and fairs that are organised in the plaza regularly and indeed on pedestrians going from the library to the church and shops.

For the mast to be effective and cover an area within a radius of 500 to 700 meters the signal has to pass above the roof of the church hence the need for a 20m mast. This clearly demonstrates that the location is not suitable. A lower mast (with a lesser visual impact) would suffice in a more suitable location. Masts are already installed on the adjoining shopping centre.

Schools are deemed not suitable as sites for masts and due to the proximity of the site in this instance it appears that Ontower are expedient with their choice of location. The location of the site is on church ground next to the Ballyroan Community and Youth Centre and the mast would overlook and overshadow the playground used by the crèche and childminding facilities offered by the Ballyroan Community and Youth Centre. While there is no conclusive evidence for the pros and cons of the danger of emissions from antennas and other electronic equipment on masts, allowing such a structure near a children's playing space should not be risked.
