We all depend on a level of phone signal that allows us to communicate with family and friends and to carry out basic functions such as internet banking which now requires phone authentication, both of these are currently very difficult because of the poor signal. In the future we will be depending on our phones for more of these functions and for us this will become more difficult without a quality phone signal.

We sincerely hope that SDCC gives approval for this mast for our benefit and the benefit of others who are living in this "dead zone" phone area.
