Serena's likely to slip away

BORIS BECKER fears that slipping Serena Williams may have played her last match at Wimbledon.

The 39-year-old superstar retired in the first set of her first-round clash on Tuesday night with an injured leg on the slippery Centre Court grass.

Several players lost their footing on the surface and SW19 chiefs blamed the wet weather.

German Becker, 53, the three-time singles winner, said: "It's the last thing that a champion like Serena wants to do — leave her favourite courts with a walkover."

"We've got to get used to the fact this might be the last time."

"She is past 30. It's another year of coming back, injuries, wear-and-tear, she also had an injury at the French Open."

"It is sad to see but time waits for no man or woman."

Tim Henman, a former Wimbledon darling and now on the Wimbledon board, said the grass is always "lush" at the start of the two-week Championships.
