Dear Sir/Madam,

We are Gerard and Linda Proudfoot of 3 Orchardstown Villas, Rathfarnham, Dublin 14 Eircode D14CH76 and we are making reference to the above planning application. We wish to make following observations to this application:

- We object to the proposed structure being built in a low rise area such as Ballyroan.
- The structure is proposed in an area that is intended for people to gather. It will obstruct the goings on of our community, which regularly hosts events, gatherings, Fairs and Fetes. We have personal experience how this plaza provides a unique focal point and gathering place for our community events. The structure, along with its associated cabinets will be detrimental to these events and will also disturb the comings and goings of daily life for people visiting the library, church and Community Centre.
- This structure is completely out of place in this community thoroughfare.
- The location of the structure will completely dominate the nearby Community
 Centre, with its Creche and childminding facilities and will impact negatively upon
 these enterprises. These structures should not be placed in close proximity to where
 very young children are being cared for and educated.
- Great consideration was taken when the design and buildings of the Community
 Centre and Parish Centre as each building takes each other into consideration
 bringing a uniform landscape and a sense of structural balance. This massive
 structure would be misplaced and detrimentally disturb our residential community
 landscape
- The existing structure which is on Ballyroan Parish grounds is an important expression of 1960s architecture and there is a protection order on it. The removal of this structure would go against the order.
- The location of the planning application states that the structure stands in the yard
 of the Ballyroan Community and Youth Centre. This is incorrect as it is on part of the
 existing grounds of Ballyroan Church.

On the basis of the above, I trust our observations will be taken into account when considering this application. I also enclose, below, our receipt for the planning objection fee which we submitted to your Finance office.
