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### PLANNING APPLICATIONS

**DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL** - We, Lululemon Athletica Ireland Ltd, intend to apply to the above named authority for planning permission for development at 84 Grafton Street, Dublin 2, D02 FN36. The development will consist of the removal of the existing signage and the provision of new signage to the front facade of the existing retail store and all associated site works. The proposed development is located within an Architectural Conservation Area.
