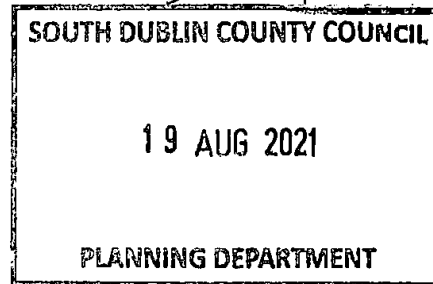

It has come to my attention, that there is a planning application for the development of land behind me in Rookwood House (Weir property). I would like to make the following observation.

1. I understand that 46 trees will be felled to make way for new construction and the remaining trees on site will receive remedial treatment. This breaches South Dublin County Council's Climate Action Plan which commits to increasing the canopy cover provided by trees while promoting retention of existing tree canopy cover.
