This road is already catering for traffic which makes access and egress from the estate (Kilnamanagh) very difficult.

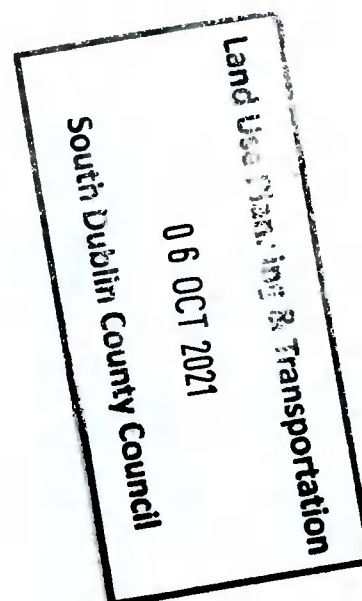
While I have no problem with McHugh Components LTD, trying to enlarge their business it cannot be at the expense of people living and working in the area.
