Kerry legends join forces in bid to take over management

THREE players who were instrumental in drawing a line under Kerry's longest football famine could get a shot at ending their latest one.

Stephen Stack, Seamus Moynihan and Dara Ó Cinnéide, who were All-Ireland-winning team-mates in 1997 when Kerry bridged an 11-year wait for the Sam Maguire, are heading a high-powered ticket seeking to take over the management of the county team, who last won the Championship in 2014.

Stack, corner-back on the '97 team, is being put forward as manager and is understood to have been interviewed by board chiefs in the past 24 hours.

The high-profile nature of the ticket is likely to give rise to concerns as to who will be in charge. However, Donie Buckley is deemed to be the most important figure on the ticket and would have the 'loudest voice' in the group on the coaching side, with Moynihan also having a very hands-on role in the management of the group.

As reported by *Sportsmail* last week, former manager Mickey 'Ned' O'Sullivan is included on the ticket, along with Joe O'Connor - a two-time All-Ireland-winning and

conditioning coach with the Clare (2013) and Limerick (2018) hurlers.

Five-time All-Ireland winner Aidan O'Mahony is also understood to have been signed up to work with O'Connor in an S&C role.

It represents a stellar line-up -

including three All-Ireland-winning captains in O'Sullivan (1975), Moynihan (2000) and Ó Cinnéide (2004) - while Buckley's status as one of the game's top coaches has not been denied despite his axing by Peter Keane from the role last year.

While Stack might be the least well-known of the 1997 trio, he brings with him a management CV that includes leading his home

club Austin Stacks to a county title in 2014 - their first in 20 years.

He was also the outlier on that '97 team as the only player in the group with an All-Ireland medal, having won one as a sub under Mick O'Dwyer in 1986.

However, despite the group putting together a heavy-hitting ticket, the outgoing Keane and three-time All-Ireland-winning boss Jack O'Connor also remain in the frame for the post.

It is believed Keane's position has been boosted as result of a significant number of players having expressed support for the outgoing manager.

The Kerry players met last week for what was a review of their season rather than to discuss the ongoing process to appoint the next manager, but support for Keane, under whom several of the panel won All-Ireland minor medals, is understood to be strong among several of the group.

The decision to proceed with a selection process was interpreted by some media commentators as a mark of disrespect to Keane, but it is believed he was

given assurances that, if he reapplied, he would be given serious consideration by the five-man sub-committee appointed

to recommend the next manager. It is understood that Keane has already been interviewed by the committee.
