Proposed Fence & Gate at St Oliver's Training Centre, Wheatfield Road, Dublin 22

Dear Sirs

On behalf of Dublin Dún Laoghaire ETB, I attach a planning application for a 2.4 metre high steel palisade fence and gate at the south side of St Oliver's Training Centre.

The reason for the fence is that horses are being kept in the field to the rear of the Centre and taken through a lane which is shared with the Centre.

The existing fence is only 1.2 M high and horses have crossed this at times upsetting the staff and students. This is why a higher fence is needed.

It is proposed to create a new pedestrian entrance (exempt from planning permission) on the northern side of the site and use the lane only for deliveries.

There is no car parking on site and staff have the use of part of the Wheatfield Prison Car Park nearby.

The fence is to be steel palisade design with rounded (not spiked) tops and painted dark green.
