Agony for England but Morgan's got dreams

EOIN MORGAN described the England dressing room as 'devastated' as their hopes of T20 World Cup glory were ended after an agonising semi-final defeat against New Zealand - but he has resisted to stay on as limited-overs captain. New Zealand laid the ghosts of the 2019 50-over World Cup final to rest at a blustery Abu Dhabi as Daryl Mitchell's 72 not out from 47 balls helped the Black Caps chase down 167 with five wickets and six balls to spare. England were aiming to become the first nation to hold both white-ball World Cup trophies simultaneously but that bid will roll over to Australia in 12 months' time, where Dubliner Morgan is optimistic of still being at the helm. 'I hope so, I'm still offering enough within the side,' he said afterwards. 'I absolutely love playing cricket at the moment for that changing room... I'm incredibly proud to be the leader.'

SHANE LOWRY is among four of Europe's Ryder Cup team bidding to equal a PGA Tour record in this week's Hewlett-Packard Enterprise Houston Open. Players from outside the United States have won the last five events on the Tour, one shy of the record set in 2004 and equalled in 2008. South Korea's Sungjae Im started the run with victory in the Shriners Children's Open in Las Vegas and was followed into the winner's circle by Rory McIlroy, Hideki Matsuyama, Lucas Herbert and Viktor Hovland. Tyrrell Hatton, Shane Lowry, Lee Westwood and Ian Poulter will tee it up at Memorial Park in an attempt to make it six wins in a row for an international contingent which also includes Ireland's Seamus Power and 2016 Masters cham-

pion Danny Willett. Defending champion Carlos Ortiz has been ruled out however, the world No49 pulling out of the tournament due to an ongoing shoulder injury. Ortiz became the first Mexican to win on the PGA Tour for 42 years thanks to a closing 65 last year which left him two shots ahead of Matsuyama and Dustin Johnson. World No12 Tony Finau is the top ranked player in the field, with former No1 and four-time major winner Brooks Koepka looking to find some form following a missed cut in Mayakoba last week. Koepka, who has not had a top-10 finish since July's Open Championship, was the player consultant for architect Tom Doak's redesign of Memorial Park before it hosted the event in. Meanwhile, Stephen Gallacher's 600th European Tour appearance will technically be

his last, but the former Ryder Cup player could hardly be happier. Gallacher was in the audience for Tuesday's announcement that the European Tour will become the DP World Tour from the start of the 2022 season, with total prize money exceeding \$200million (€174m) for the first time. The season-ending DP World Tour Championship will have a prize fund of \$10m - the first regular European Tour event with an eight-figure purse - while all tournaments solely sanctioned by the DP World Tour will have a minimum prize fund of \$2m. 'It's a great week for the Tour,' Gallacher said ahead of his 600th start in this week's AVI. 'To come through a pandemic and to get such a positive boost with DP World investing in the DP World Tour, it's going to help the Challenge Tour, grassroots golf globally. 'I think we are in a fantastic position in golf.'
