Dear Sir / Madam

I'm writing to make an observation on the proposed development at Stocking Lane, Ballyboden (case number 311616) by MacCabe Durney Barnes Ltd.

While I am not opposed to the development of the site, I have considerable concerns with the current submission which has not rectified some of the items that were listed by An Bord Pleanála when they previously refused application (ABP-308763-20). As the new submission still materially contravenes housing policy I recommend that permission should be refused based upon the following observations:

1) Location, Scale & Proximity of Apartment block:

The proposed height and location of the apartment block is of concern and out of character with the surrounding area:

- a) The proposed location of the three story 'Block H' is less than the required 35 meters from the neighbouring houses in Prospect Heath (specifically No.9 Prospect Heath) and only 4.2meters from the boundary of the site. This contravenes Housing (H) Policy 9 Objective 3 requiring proposals to comply with Section 11.2.7 of the South Dublin County Development Plan 2016-2022, which states that new residential development that would adjoin existing one and/or two-storey housing, shall be no more than two storeys in height, unless a separation distance of 35m or greater is achieved,
- b) The proposed height of the apartment block nearest Prospect Manor 3 floors is excessive for this location and contravenes Section 11.2.7 of the SDCC Development Plan which states "The appropriate maximum or minimum height of any building will be determined by: The prevailing building height of existing housing in the surrounding area."

5. Grounds



According to the South Dublin County Council Development Plan, this site is zoned as Residential, with an *objective to protect and/or improve the residential amenity*. In my view the proposed development neither protects or nor improves the residential amenity and is in fact injurious to it.

I hope you will give my submission your consideration when reviewing the planning application for the proposed development of Prospect House.
