With reference to your application for a Declaration of Exemption under Section 5 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 received on 10-Nov-2021 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under Section 5 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended), **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION** must be submitted as follows:

1. Under Class 9, ‘the construction, erection, renewal or replacement, other than within or bounding the curtilage of a house, of any gate or gateway has a limitation to requiring that ‘the height of any such structure shall not exceed 2 metres.’
The applicant is requested to submit an elevation of the proposed gate and confirm that the height of the structure shall not exceed 2m.

The Council cannot give further consideration to your application for a Declaration until you submit the items sought in this Request for Additional Information.
