TASMANIAN CRICKET DETERMINED TO 'SALVAGE' PAINE'S REPUTATION

Andrew Gaggin added there was growing anger over the handling of the crisis by Cricket Australia towards a man he described as 'a beacon' who was instrumental in 'salvaging the reputation of the national team' after Sandpaper-gate.

Gaggin stated that a board meeting had unanimously reiterated their support for Paine before adding that the exchange was 'consensual and private'. Paine was appointed captain in March 2018, four months after the

text exchange, and kept his post after an inquiry three months later when he was cleared by both Cricket Australia and Cricket Tasmania after a complaint by the woman involved. But CA chairman Richard Freudenstein, who was not in the role at the time, denied accusations of a cover-up by saying the current board would have stripped Paine of the captaincy. Remarkably, Paine remains in the Ashes squad.
