Development: The proposed development will consist of amendments to the permitted development previously granted under South Dublin County Council Reg Ref. Nos. SD19A/0345, SD20A/0322 and SD21A/0071. The proposed development consists of: 1) retention permission for the inclusion of 2 no. windows (c.4 sq.m) at mezzanine level of the permitted supermarket building (under construction); and 2) planning permission is sought for i) the erection of 1 no. double sided totem sign (c.32 sq.m) at the north-east of the site; ii) externally mounted illuminated signage (c. 5 sq.m.) over the main entrance door of the supermarket building; and iii) all associated elevational changes, site services and site development works. on lands principally bounded by : Stocking Avenue to the north; an internal access road associated with the White Pines residential development to the east; and Stocking Wood residential scheme to the south and west.


