I wish to make a submission in relation to the above planning reference. I confirm I have paid the €20 fee.

Firstly, I would like to make it clear that this is not an objection to the planning application, but a request for a condition to be imposed should planning be granted.

I politely request, as a condition of any planning grant, that the footpath outside the subject site be kept intact in its current form and remain clear from obstruction for the duration of the construction period and thereafter. The footpath outside a similar site nearby (planning reference SDZ13A/0002) has been in poor condition and impassable for wheelchair and pram users for close to four years and the site owners have refused to take responsibility for this and reinstate the path. We need to ensure this is avoided with the new construction and making it a condition of the planning will go some way to ensuring this happens. This condition should be included in the interest of health and safety of the general public.

I trust the above will be taken into consideration.
