

Djokovic could face locker-room ban

Ambition: Rafa Nadal impresses yesterday

NOVAK DJOKOVIC could be exiled from tennis even if he is allowed to enter tournaments, with the ATP Tour expected to ban unvaccinated players from locker rooms and other on-site facilities. Instructions sent to players at lower-tier events in Italy spell out draconian restrictions which apply to the few who remain unjabbed. According to ATP sources, there is an expectation that these will be brought in across the tour to avoid the kind of confusion seen in Melbourne, where Djokovic had his visa cancelled a day before he was due to begin the defence of his Australian Open title. A series of Challenger events are going on in Italy, a country which also hosts one of the classic clay-court opens and the year-end tour finals. The document states that unvaccinated players are

allowed to compete provided they return a negative Covid test every 48 hours. However, in highlighted red type it goes on to say: 'They will not be allowed to use any tournament facilities (locker rooms, gym, on-site cafes etc), restaurants or hotels.' They are described as

government-imposed measures, but discussions are taking place for these regulations to be applied more widely across tour events. Meanwhile, Rafa Nadal said his game is improving with every match since his return from a lengthy injury break after the Spaniard eased past Yannick

Hanfmann 6-2 6-3 6-4 to reach the third round of the Australian Open yesterday. The only former champion left in the men's draw at Melbourne Park, Nadal is tied on 20 majors with the injured Roger Federer and departed Djokovic. A second Australian Open title would not only break the three-way tie at the top of men's tennis but also make Nadal just the second man after Djokovic to win each of the four Grand Slam titles twice since the sport became professional in 1968. Nadal has, however, repeatedly said that his only objective at this year's opening major was to stay healthy, having returned to the Tour after recovering from a long-standing foot problem and contracting Covid-19 last month. Defending champion Naomi Osaka beat American Madison Brengle 6-0 6-4 to reach the third round, staying on course for a potential fourth-round clash with world number one and local favourite Ash Barty.
