

# SOUTH DUBLIN COUNTY COUNCIL

## SITE NOTICE

We, EdgeConneX Ireland Limited are applying for retention permission for development within the townland of Grange at this site to the rear of Takeda Ireland Limited, Grange Castle, Lucan, Co. Dublin.

The development will consist of the retention and continuance of the use for a further two years of the temporary gas powered generation plant, that is located to the rear of the Takeda Ireland complex, that is sited within a walled yard of 2,836sqm containing 12 no. generator units with associated flues (each 15m high), that was permitted initially for a period of three years under Reg. Ref. SD16A/0345; and subsequently extended for an additional period of 2 years from the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2020 under Condition no. 2 of permission granted under SD19A/0342. Vehicular access to the generation plant will remain from the permitted service road into the Edgeconnex site and Grange Castle Business Park as originally permitted.

The planning application may be inspected or purchased at the offices of South Dublin County Council, County Hall, Town Centre, Tallaght, Dublin 24 during its public opening hours of Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 4:00pm., and may also be viewed on the Council's website – [www.sdcc.ie](http://www.sdcc.ie).

A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to South Dublin County Council on payment of a fee of €20 within 5 weeks of receipt of the application by South Dublin County Council and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Planning Authority in making a decision on the application. The Planning Authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions or may refuse to grant permission.
