DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL : Shared access Ltd is applying to the above planning authority for full Planning permission for the erection of a 2.4m telecommunications mast, together with associated communications equipment, radio equipment housing, fencing and all associated site works at Oscar Traynor Coaching and development Centre, Oscar Traynor Road, Coolock, Dublin 17.
