Dublin, D24 PKK8.**


which is located in an Architectural Conservation Area.

The development will consist of:

- (i) Change of use from Bookmakers (when last used) to a community-based Resource Centre / Wellness Centre, to be operated by Dublin Vineyard CLG.**
- (ii) Internal alterations and modifications, including removal of internal walls and the part levelling of floors to assist with achieving universal access.**
- (iii) New hardwood sign fitted to the existing signage frame.**
- (iv) Replacement of the two external doors to the street with new, painted hardwood doors.**

A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to the Planning Authority, on payment of a fee of €20 within 5 weeks of receipt of the application by South Dublin County Council and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Planning Authority in making a decision on the application. The Planning Authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions or may refuse to grant permission.
